- Please bring all food items to the concession stand upon your arrival
- All Beverages should be brought in a cooler ( with your name on it)
- Please have all food items there by 10 AM
- ALL food is free, Donation Excepted
- Grill and food table help please arrive for your shifts in a timely manner. We want the other help to be able to get out and enjoy the games as well.

### **Parking:**

- Field marshalls will be provided a radio, orange vests, air horn and binder with the schedule of games for those fields.
- Your primary role is to keep the game flowing on your field and to ensure the games are moving in a timely matter. And the field is running on time.
- If any issues begin on the fields please call me on the radio and we will make sure that those issues are resolved
- Just float between the fields and enjoy the games.

### **Referees**

- The referees will be VOLUNTEERING their time at the festival
- Please be respectful to them throughout the day.
- If there is not a referee on the field, coaches share the responsibility of officiating the game
- The clock is not kept by the referee. All time is managed by the field marshalls wit the air horn.
